- Open to K-5th grade students in Brazos, Bellville, Columbus, Rice & Sealy School Districts.
- All artwork must be the student's **original, individual, hand-done creation** (no group projects or coloring sheets). You may not use images directly from the internet, magazines or other such media.
- All artwork must be 8.5" x 11" OR 9"x12" without a mat, frame or border. **Acceptable art medium is crayon only.**
- Artwork must not exceed 1/4 inch in total thickness and must be an original design and not a colored rendition of the attached horizontal artwork. The subject of your work must be the Attwater's Prairie-Chicken, its prairie habitat, or other coastal prairie species. More information on this unique bird and its habitat may be found on our website at www.Attwater.org and on page six.
- **No lettering, signatures, or initials may appear on the front of the design.** Any artwork with such identifying characteristics will be disqualified and eliminated from the competition.
- **Use a CLEAR GLUE STICK to affix your completed entry form to the back of the artwork. PLEASE ... DO NOT FOLD, STAPLE, PAPER CLIP OR TAPE....it damages the artwork!**

- All artwork must be **8.5" x 11" OR 9"x12"** without a mat, frame or border. - All artwork must be the student's **original individual hand-done creation** (no group projects). Photographs will not be accepted. You may not use images directly from the internet, magazines or other such media.
- All artwork must be **8.5" x 11" OR 9"x12"** without a mat, frame or border. Acceptable art mediums may include (**but are not limited to**) oils, acrylics, scratch-board, pointillism, chalk, pastels, colored pencil, charcoal, dry brush, watercolor, crosshatch, lead, collage, linoleum printing, or computer generated graphic design. (**Please note: if contestants use chalk, pastels or lead they should seal it with an appropriate fixative**).
- Artwork must not exceed 1/4 inch in total thickness. The subject of your design must be the Attwater's Prairie-Chicken, its prairie habitat, or other coastal prairie species. More information on this unique bird and its habitat may be found on our website at www.Attwater.org and on page six.

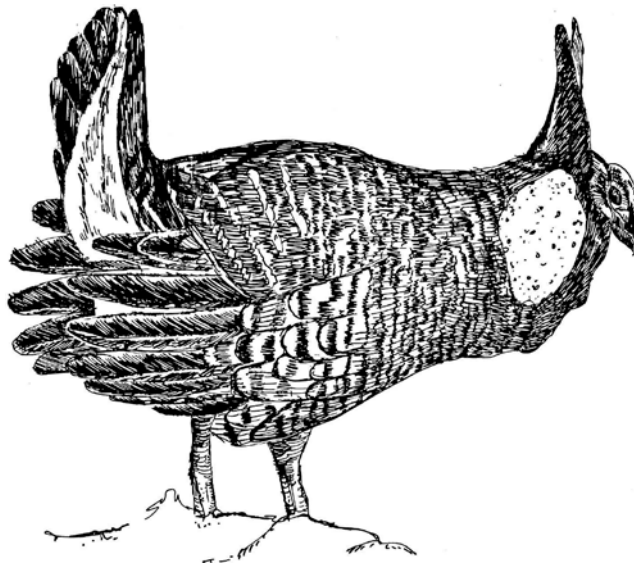

Meet the Attwater's Prairie-Chicken

The Attwater Prairie Chicken National Wildlife Refuge, www.fws.gov/refuge/AttwaterPrairieChicken is located approximately 60 miles west of Houston, Texas, is one of the largest remnants of coastal prairie habitat remaining in Southeast Texas and home to one of the last populations of the critically endangered Attwater's prairie chicken, a ground-dwelling grouse of the coastal prairie ecosystem. The refuge is one of a handful of national wildlife refuges managed specifically for an endangered species and was created to preserve prairie habitat specifically for the preservation of this unique species. The Attwater's Prairie Chicken is a unique subspecies of the Greater Prairie-Chicken (*Tympanuchus cupido*) a member of the Grouse Family. The Attwater's subspecies is found on the coastal Texas Prairies (now in danger of extinction), is smaller and darker (length = 17", wing-span 28").* During the spring the Prairie Chickens can be found on an area of the prairie known as the leks. The males display by dancing (much like the plains Indians did) and filling their yellow-orange air sacks located on their necks. When expelling the air a low hooting sound much like blowing across a bottle, is heard known as "Booming."
